Village of Lindell Civic Assoc 09-10 Dues

This past winter, snow plowing fees were \$7,805.00. We were reimbursed \$4,550.38 from the DELDOT community program. Our final cost was \$3, 254.62. We have to first pay for the snow plowing, then submit info to DELDOT and wait 3-4 weeks for reimbursement. If we have another, or worse, winter like we had, we will not have the funds to cover snow plowing prior to reimbursement.

We have received dues from ONLY 69 of the 215 homes in Village of Lindell. We have one of the lowest dues in this area, only **\$20 a year!**
